1. Good quality files (recommended Friedrich Dick\* files or alternatively Vallorbe files):

2. Hand (flat) engineer's file with handle cut 0 length 250 or 300 mm
3. Hand (flat) engineer's file with handle cut 4 length 200 mm
4. Half-round engineer's file with handle cut 0 length 250 or 300 mm
5. Half-round engineer's file with handle cut 4 length 200 mm
6. Square engineer's file cut 2 with handle length 200 mm
7. A set of needle files cut 4 (square, round, half-round, flat, knife)
8. Emery paper, at least a couple of sheets of the following grit: 180 grit, 240 grit, 400 grit, 600 grit, 800 grit, 1000 grit
9. Piercing saw with saw blades (size 2 and 4)
10. One pair of comfortable leather working gloves
11. Protective goggles
12. For those who intend making a scraper or any other tool that requires sharpening: a sharpening stone (Natural Belgian stone or alternatively Arkansas stone)
